




COVID-19 IMPACT TIMELINE








MHI June-21: Improvements in 20-39 years old Females




PTSD leads to worsening of Cognition & Resilience




Worse Memory
5% worse in PTSD




Worse Sustained Attention
18% worse in PTSD




Lower Resilience
11% worse in PTSD




Worse Controlled Attention
